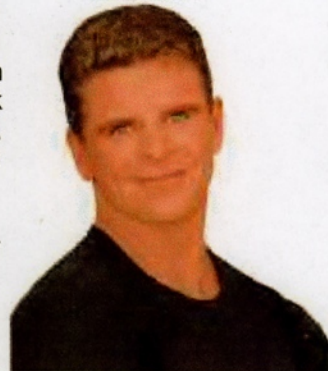

Muscling In On Beverly Park

Fitness guru **Bill Phillips**, author of the bestselling book *Body for Life*, has purchased a brand-new home in the celebrity enclave of Beverly Park in Los Angeles. The 2-acre property, which includes a 17,000-square-foot main house, a 3,000-square-foot guesthouse and a pool, closed for just under \$15 million. Developed by the firm of Dugally-Oberfeld—which also built the homes of fellow Beverly Park residents **Sylvester Stallone** and **Denzel Washington**—the property is about three months away from completion, according to **Hilton & Hyland** agent **Mauricio Umansky**, who handled the sale.

A former bodybuilder, Phillips found commercial success marketing nutritional supplements through the company **Experimental and Applied Sciences (EAS)**. His biggest seller became a supplement called creatine, which was promoted for some time by players for the Denver Broncos. Though it no longer dominates the market for creatine, EAS continues to be a leader in the estimated \$1.5 billion-a-year sports nutritional supplement industry. Phillips stepped down as chief executive in 1999, but remains a minority shareholder and a member of the EAS company board.

Wathnes Sell On Nantucket

The three sisters who own **Wathne**, a manufacturer of high-end sportswear based in New York, have just sold their home on Nantucket. Named "Three Terns," the 4,200-square-foot house with ocean views closed for \$7,765,000. George Ballantyne of Sotheby's International Realty in Boston brokered the sale.
